Job description

Promote climate pledge/ oath for scientists

- Create a menu of significant actions which scientists and engineers can sign up to, to reduce their carbon footprint, e.g. stop flying, switch to a plant-based diet, replace car-use with train/bus/cycle/walking options
- Publicise the pledge/ oath to the science and engineering community, and environmental and peace campaigners, and enrol signatories
- As the number of signatories increases, publicise these to the media, policy-makers, and other relevant audiences

Lobby professional science and engineering associations

- Carry out a brief update of the key data compiled in SGR's *Irresponsible Science?* report on financial links between leading professional engineering and science organisations (PESOs) and fossil fuel and arms corporations
- Write to these PESOs urging them to review, reduce and cease financial links with fossil fuel and arms corporations
- Based on responses to these letters, encourage members of these organisations to write to the board and/or members' magazines to encourage action towards ending financial links
- Invite these organisations to consider urgently what it would mean for them to act in accordance with a transition pathway compatible with the 1.5°C Paris target and, based on that consideration, rapidly implement plans to make the pathway real
- Publicise these actions to the media, science and engineering community, environmental and peace campaigners, policy-makers etc
