

Campaigner: militarisation of science education

Job description

- Update and expand SGR's campaign and education materials on the militarisation of science and its alternatives, including some or all of the following:
 - Writing/ editing web-pages, including SGR's Globally Responsible Careers resources;
 - Recording/ editing short video interviews with scientists and engineers who have left military work or avoided it altogether;
 - Write articles or short briefings on relevant ethical issues in science and technology, e.g. military uses of AI, UK arms exports to war zones/ oppressive regimes, military impacts on the environment.
- Work with SGR's campaign and education networks to promote SGR's materials to students, including engaging with traditional media and using social media.
- Organise campaign and education events, including online and in real life.
- Exchange learning with other campaigners on how to campaign effectively at universities and schools.
